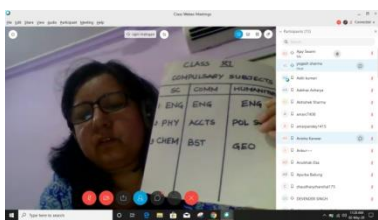
2. Video Conferences.

(a) **APS Staff Video Conference.** The staff video conference was held on 30 Apr 2020 on Cisco WebEx platform. The conference was chaired by Mrs Neena Singh, principal and was attended by entire teaching staff. Principal instructed staff to create groups of class XI students in all three streams of Science, Commerce & Humanities and to begin the classes. She directed staff that for the first week the classes would be conducted on a trail basis just to give children an insight into the subject and that would help them in deciding subject of their choice. She emphasized that students should be assessed regularly to check their learning.

(b) **AWES Day Celebrations.** 38th AWES Day was celebrated by the children of APS Bikaner amid COVID-19 Pandemic on 29 April 2020. Children prepared cards, posters and made drawings to celebrate the spirit of AWES.

(c) **Orientation Session for Class XI Students.** Orientation Session for Class XI Students and parents was held on 02 May 2020. The aim of the session was to enable them make the correct choice of the subject depending upon their interest and future career options. With this intent, the school is proceeding ahead with the academic session for Class XI. They were allotted a stream/subjects as per her/his eligibility for it keeping in mind the Pre-board result and the internal assessments. Their Parents' consent has been taken. It was reiterated that if they get the required marks as per the eligibility criteria when the CBSE Board result is declared, their requests for changes will be looked into, subject to availability of seats.

One of the schools' best practices in the past years has been that of extending an opportunity to students to explore Science, Commerce and Humanities streams as per their eligibility to know the finer nuances of the subjects. So it is planned to conduct trail classes for one week of Class XI session.





3. Primary Section.

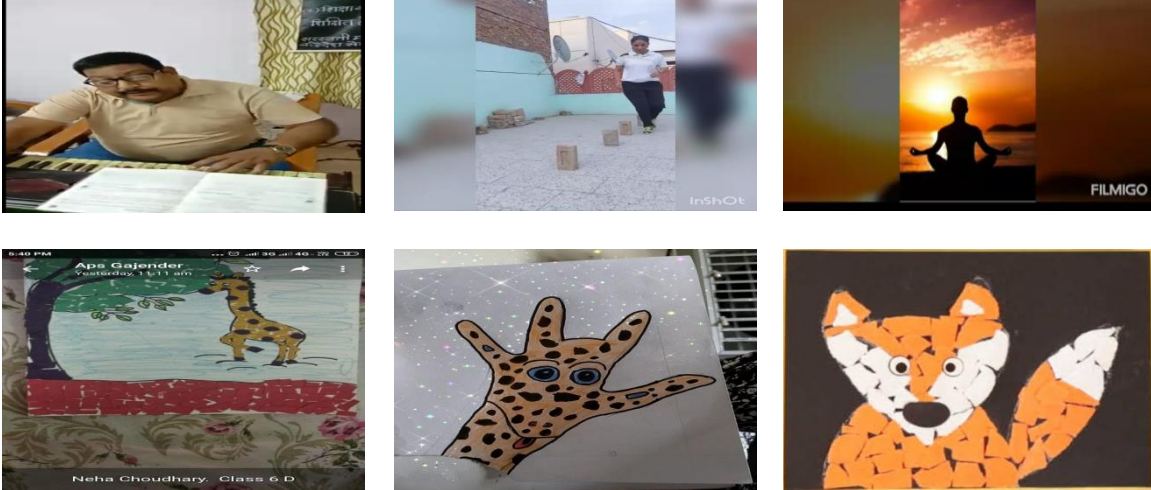
(a) **English, Hindi, Maths, Science & EVS.** In English and Hindi Worksheets were given to the students after completing the reading, explanation and written task of Chapters were given. Question answers were done. Videos and PPTs of the stories were sent to the children of all classes on WhatsApp for better understanding of the chapter. Practice worksheets based on the concept of Addition, Subtraction, Roman Numbers were sent to children of classes VI & V respectively on WhatsApp. PPTs were also sent to introduce the next Chapter. In Science Videos, PPTs & PDFs were sent to classes II to V. Recapitulation was done with the help of worksheet & Q/A.

(b) **Art and Craft.** Videos made by the subject teacher himself were shared with children to make use of craft material easily available at home. Many relevant crafts assignments were given to keep children engaged for e.g. origami butterfly, thread painting, pencil shading etc. Children really enjoyed doing these activities.

(c) **Physical Education.** A different Ten Minute Home Workout video was sent to the children on WhatsApp.

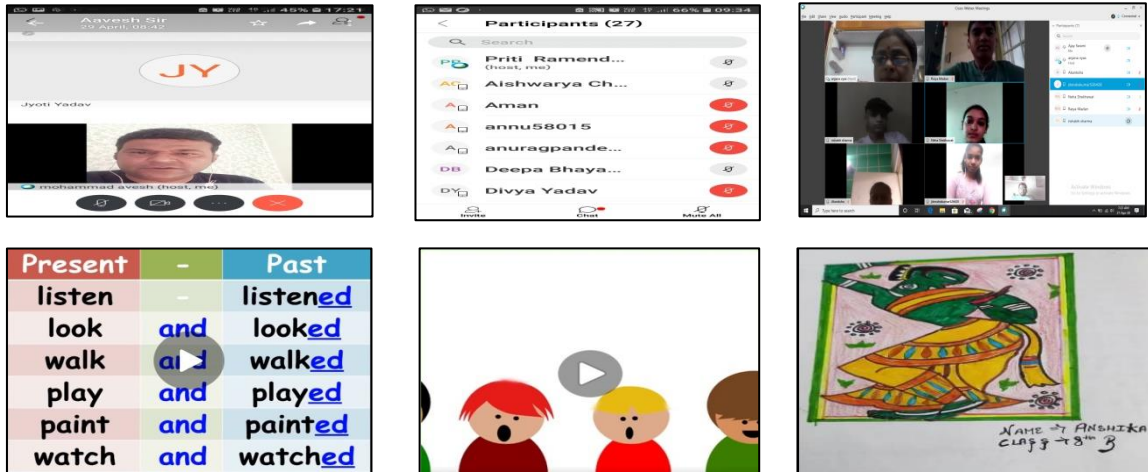
(d) **Music.** Saraswati Vandana was recorded by the music teacher in a video was sent to the children for practice.

(e) **Extra Marks Portal.** The portal is being made available to the children of school. The same is extensively being used by the children.



4. **Middle Section.**

- (a) **APS Bikaner's Cloud 'NAS'**. Various Modules, Videos, PPT, PDFs are being uploaded by the teachers on repository of school's cloud **NAS** to enable children to access the same. Teachers of all subjects have recorded their lectures and uploaded on NAS. Children are making use of this online facility for all subjects.
- (b) **Extra Marks Portal.** The Portal has been procured off the shelf and made available to the children of school for all subjects.
- (c) **Extensive Use of Social Media Platform.** WhatsApp is extensively being used for giving assignments / work sheets, recorded videos, links of reference material etc for children of all classes containing the exercises. In English/ Hindi PDFs are being sent to enhance their reading and comprehending skills. In SSt children were asked to make one chart on solar system under the guidance of the teacher. They clicked the photos and send on the same group.
- (d) **Art and Craft.** Videos were shared with children to make use of craft material easily available at home. Many relevant crafts assignments were created to keep children engaged for eg Jamini Roy Painting.
- (e) **Physical Education.** A Ten Minute Home Workout video was sent to the children on WhatsApp.
- (f) **Computer Education.** Assignments are being sent to the children on WhatsApp.



5. Senior Section.

(a) **Online Platforms for Live Classes.** Teachers conducted online classes using platforms like Webex according to the timetable provided wherein children can ask their doubts at the same time.

(b) **Online Portals.** Children can use students login to utilize following portals in their own time :-

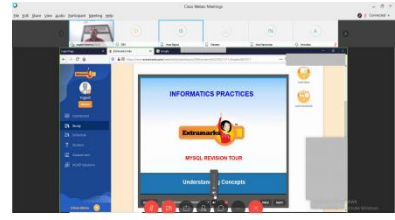
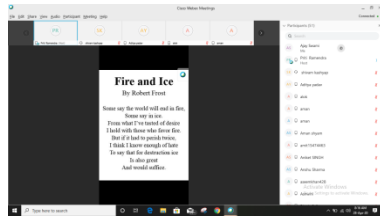
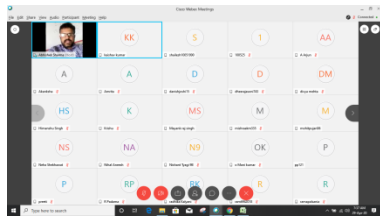
(ii) **Extra Marks Portal.** The Portal has been procured off the shelf and made available to the children of school for all subjects.

sent to the children. Online Classes are also being conducted. Students also clicked photographs of their homework and shared the same way. Regular tests are also being given to the students.

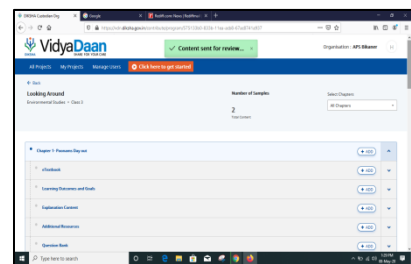
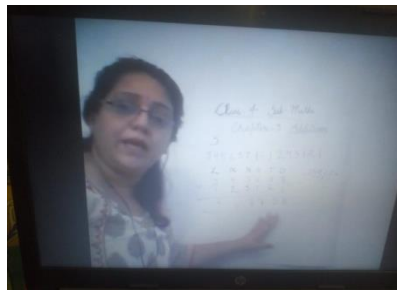


6. APS Bikaner has ensured that this week was fully utilized by most of the children. The same is being appreciated by the parents.

2. **New Admission In Class I.** The admission of all class UKG Pass outs of RAAPS to Class I has been completed and classes commenced from 11 May 2020. Online Classes are being continued.
3. **Webinar on Artificial Intelligence.** CBSE held Online Awareness and Capacity Building Programme for artificial intelligence on 14 May 2020. The board introduced Artificial Intelligence as a skill subject at secondary and senior secondary level last year along with a 12-hour 'Inspire' module meant for class 8 students. During the lockdown period, to extend its support to teachers n enable teachers to guide their students in a better way the board held capacity building programme for teachers. Teachers of APS Bikaner attended the webinar. 5. **Launch of School's You Tube Channel APSB.** Teachers of APS Bikaner have started hosting live classes over YouTube for children at home during the coronavirus outbreak.
